In this capacity he advised the mayor's office regarding a variety of issues concerning the mayor's legislative agenda as it related to the criminal justice system.

After moving into private practice, Mr. Koster was a founding partner of Callan, Koster, Brady & Brennan, LLP. He currently serves as managing partner of the firm. In this capacity he has been involved in a wide variety of insurance defense litigation, including products liability, professional liability, medical malpractice, and general liability. Other areas of specialty include labor law, employment practices litigation and insurance coverage issues.
